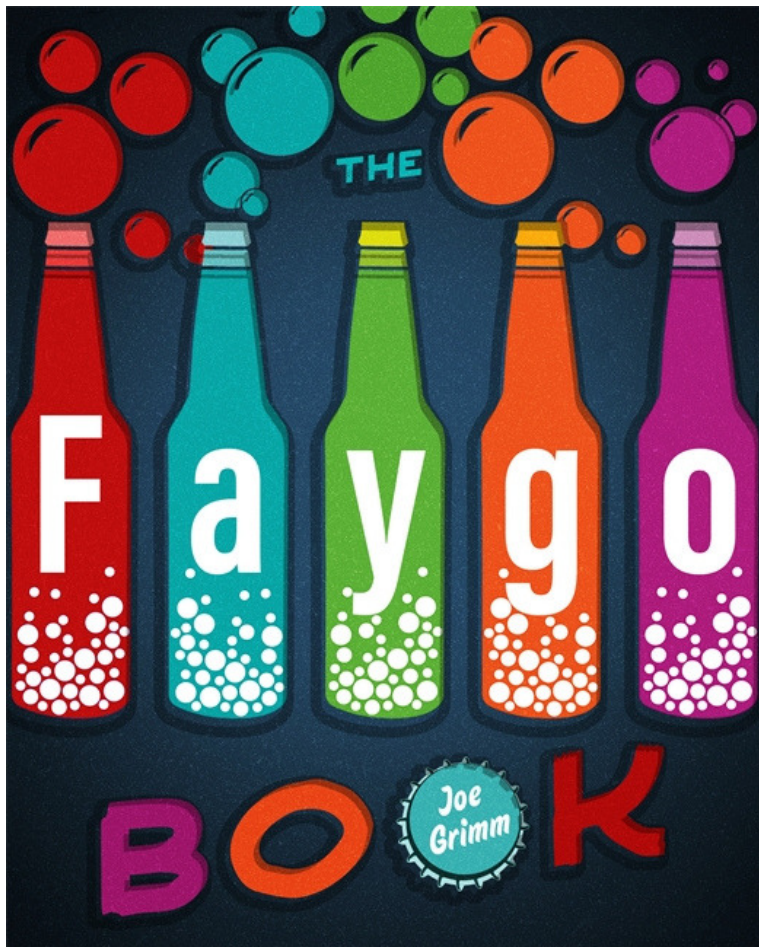


# The Faygo Book
