

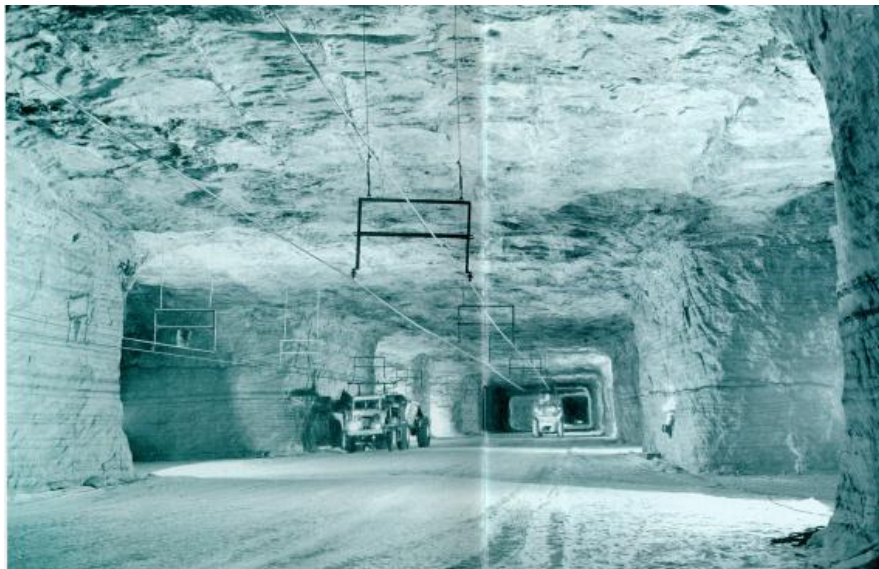
Detroit Salt Mine

Thursday, July 18, 6 pm, Miller Library

Some 1,200 feet beneath the streets of Detroit run 100 miles of subterranean roads over an area of more than 1,500 acres. It is the Detroit Salt Mine, and, as a Detroit industry, it is older than automobiles. As a geological entity, this salt deposit is older even than the dinosaurs.



George L. Davis, Public Affairs and Public Safety Manager at Detroit Salt Company will discuss the historic geologic and industrial wonder that is the Detroit Salt Mine. Davis will present the mine's history, its basic operations, and its role as an economic hub.
