What is the Point in Time Count (PIT)?

Point in Time is an annual sheltered and unsheltered count of people experiencing homelessness that is conducted across the nation in the last week of January each year. The PIT Count is essential to gain a better understanding of the number of people who are experiencing homelessness in Oakland County on any given night. The data gathered helps shape policy and programs designed to assist some of our most vulnerable residents.

Volunteers

Volunteers create a team to go out and canvas the city together. Volunteers can either be Team Leader, or a Team Member. Team Leaders have a bit more responsibility, as they are the ones who recruit their Team Members, along with training them in preparation for PIT.

New Team Leaders are also required to watch a training webinar & sign off on a waiver indicating that they watched the training and understand how to guide their team through PIT night. Please email Ashley at aburton-alliance@oaklandhomeless.org for this information.
