We will explain what a Functional Behavior Analysis (FBA) is, and how a FBA leads to the development of a Behavior Intervention Plan (BIP) that utilizes Positive Behavior Supports (PBS).

Who should attend? Parents, caregivers, school staff, and professionals who work with children/young adults with disabilities, learning difficulties, professional, service providers, caregivers, school staff.
