2018 INSERVICE PROGRAM CALENDAR

January 26th, 2018 Motivational Treatment Planning

Presenter: Steve Meerschaert, LPC, CAADC, NCC

Location: St. John Macomb Hospital Auditorium

Course Description: This course will be geared toward the application of Motivational Interviewing (MI) approaches and techniques for use in treatment planning sessions. Compliance and consistency are pivotal factors in mental health and recovery from substance use disorders as well as a wide range of other behavioral disorders (OCD, Self-Harm, Eating Disorders), and this presentation will aim to guide application of motivational interviewing concepts and techniques to improve rapport, focused treatment sessions and outcomes with ambivalent and difficult clients.

February 23rd, 2018 Ethics for the Mental Health and Substance Use Treatment Professional

Presenter: Michelle Mualem, LMSW, ASCW, CPHQ, CAADC, CCS-M

Location: Providence Park Hospital, Conference rooms A, B, and C

Course Description: This course will provide an overview of the history and evolution of social work and other behavioral health and addiction ethics as well as a biomedical ethics and ethics theories. The course will cover use common ethical discernment tools. Discussion and case examples will demonstrate how to address general ethical situations, including electronic communications, as well as situations that involve legal and regulatory issues.

March 23rd, 2018 Assisting with Treatment Issues Associated with the LGBTQ Population

Presenter: Sara VanDenBerg, PsyD, LLP, CAADC

Location: St. John Macomb Hospital Auditorium

Course Description: This course will provide information of working with the LGBTQ population in treatment. An overview of terminology of both a positive and negative nature will be discussed as well as treatment goals and complications while working with the LGBTQ population. The stages of coming out and their affect on therapy will be elaborated upon via media and experiential means. This topic addresses the rising need to address cultural diversity with the LGBTQ population and how to effectively treat this population while avoiding bias and discrimination

April 20th, 2018 Use of Resilience and Vulnerability in Psychotherapy

Presenter: Daniel Stettner, PhD, LP

Location: St. John Macomb Hospital Auditorium

Course Description: This program explores the research on vulnerability and resilience with children, adolescents, and adults. Participants receive didactic information of these issues to help them better understand how vulnerability and resilience effect the backgrounds of their clients, general clinical presentation as a client in treatment, and how the past effects present and future. The participant also is free to ask questions, add personal and professional input to the presentation, making it more relevant for the attendee's experience of being there. Participants also receive very specific and detailed information about what clinicians are doing with research and clinical protocols for treatment with children, adolescents, and adults – making use of vulnerabilities and client resilience. Thus, participants receive both the understanding about these two major clinical themes; and how to integrate treatment models into their personal caseloads and clinical skill set as mental health practitioners.

May 18th, 2018 Treating Sexual Addiction and Pornography Addiction

Presenter: Nancy Bregier, LPC, NCC

Location: St. John Macomb Hospital Auditorium

Course Description: This course is an overview designed to raise awareness, knowledge, and treatments on the uncomfortable topics of Sexual Addiction and Pornography Addiction. Sexual Addiction and Pornography Addiction are process addictions as opposed to chemical addiction that is characterized by out-of-control (compulsive) behaviors with

marked consequences. Special attention will be paid to pornography addiction and the current neuroscience that reveals the effects on the brain.

June 22nd, 2018 Co-Parenting Skills for Divorced/Separated Parents

Presenter: Jordyn Havens, MA, LPC, NBCC

Location: St. John Macomb Hospital Auditorium

Course Description: This course will explore the impact that divorce and separation has on both the parents and their children. This course will identify the stages of child development and the normal reactions and responses children and teens may have after their parents separate. This course will offer coping strategies and effective communication techniques for positive and healthy co-parenting before, during, and after divorce or separation.

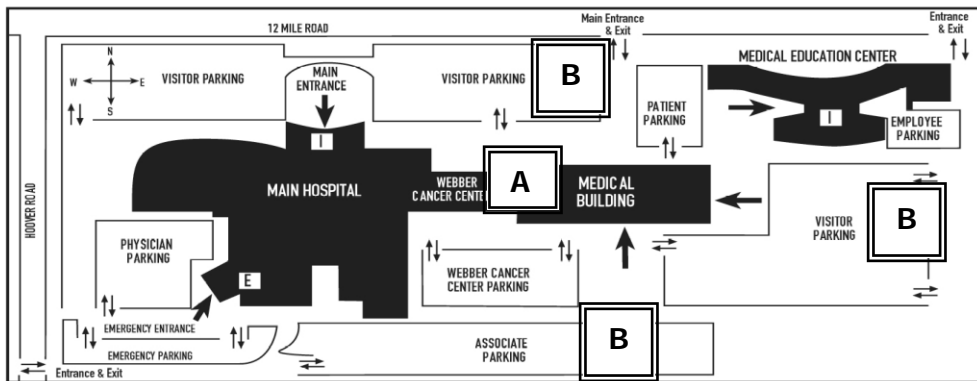
